

Training

Post training activity has already been started. The hand-holding-support meetings are being conducted for the trainees as per programmatic theme and they are assigned with social mobilization actions related to health and education basically to extend their support to both the community and government service providers. They are responsible to reach out people with the right message and bring them to focus of services.

In the hand-holding-support meeting the trained women are provided with the health and education related data and based on which few important indicators are set to ensure the starting point of action and measuring the progress of intervention from time to time. The team has already been introduced to government officials and machineries to access the services.

Presently two most important indicators of health and education are identified to work with the community closely; these are institutional delivery and mother and child immunization and school drop-out and out of school children in the area for streaming them in education. In these areas of intervention the trained women address the issues at community level to ensure community's participation and advocate it with the community level influencers and government officials for ensuring services.
